

PERFIN TELEGRAPH STAMPS



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NEW INFORMATION

The original item on Telegraph perfin stamps was compiled and produced by Society member Mr John Evans in 1998 some 25 years ago.

Over the intervening years there have been various additions both to the perfin die listings and to the original information. I have taken this opportunity to up-date the Work.

Whilst providing information myself from many sources I have had input from the Perfin Society Catalogue Editor Mr. Roy Gault and from many Society members, also Telegraph stamp collectors. Dr Ian Pinwill, Stephen Panting, Steve Lawrie (Title page image) & Chris Potts who have been particularly helpful with their specialist knowledge and I am very grateful.

TELEGRAPH STAMPS

In the 1860s there were many private Telegraph companies. However, these left large areas without any telegraph service, particularly in Wales, Scotland and Ireland. This led to a demand for nationalisation and in 1868 and 1869 acts were passed giving the Postmaster General the Monopoly of Inland Telegraph business.

The first Telegraph stamps to be issued were 1d, 3d, 1/- & 5/- values on 1st of February 1876. However it soon became apparent that additional values were needed, so on the 26th March 1876 the Postmaster General gave approval for the issue of the 4d, 6d, 3/-, 10/-, £1, & £5 denominations, all of which were made available from 1st March 1877.

In the early part of 1880, following changes in some foreign rates, it became necessary to issue a ½d value which was released on 1st April 1880.

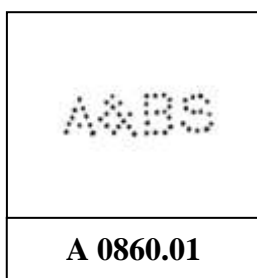
In May 1881 consideration was given to the use of Postage stamps instead of Telegraph stamps for the Telegraph service, http://www.angelfire.com/pr/perfinsoc/articals/2013_12/telegraphic.pdf The Treasury were satisfied that separate accounts could be kept. Accordingly on the 26th August 1881 the Treasury authorised the Postmaster General to abolish the use of Telegraph stamps . No further supplies were sent to the Postmaster after the 31st October. However, considerable stocks remained on hand and were supposedly destroyed. Those still in public hands could not be sold back over the counter and some ended up being used as postage, although this was never officially sanctioned.
